While on the Scientology Communication Course, Lello gained the self-confidence he needed to carry on with his career. Then Scientology

spiritual counseling removed the last of the emotional barriers and tapped into a natural ability he never knew he possessed.

“One day, after a Scientology counseling session, I performed a concert with my band. We began as usual, but we all noticed the difference—I was having the time of my life, and my enthusiasm spread through the entire group and right into the audience. We were playing better than ever before, and the audience was having a ball. At the end, the band asked me ‘What did you do?’ and my answer was ‘Scientology.’”

And the magic didn’t fade when the lights went down—the ability he regained that day has become his hallmark.

No longer beset by problems and worries, Lello became fascinated by the people and world around him. With his wife and son he strives to be the best possible husband and father, and he participates in Scientology-sponsored humanitarian campaigns to help the community in his native Milan.


